Dear Parents/Guardians,

With the new school year just around the corner, we wanted to share guidance we have received from the Arizona Department of Education and the Center for Disease and Prevention (CDC) regarding travel and the ongoing Covid-19 situation.

If your travel plans take you out of the United States of America, you have to quarantine for a period of 14 days before you will be allowed to return to school. This applies to all students, teachers, and other school staff. Anyone traveling outside of the United States of America should return by July 5th in order to start school on July 20th.

Travelers returning from out of the country should follow these steps during self-quarantine.

- Take your temperature with a thermometer two times a day and monitor for fever.
- Watch for a cough or trouble breathing.
- Stay home and avoid contact with others outside of your home.
- Do not go to work or school for the 14 days and discuss your situation with your district before returning.
- Do not take public transportation, ride-share, or buses during the time you are practicing social distancing.
- Avoid crowded places (such as shopping centers and movie theaters) and limit your activities in public and keep your distance from others (about 6 feet).

The health and safety of our students, staff, and community remain our highest priority. If you have concerns, please feel free to contact us.

Queridos Padres y/o Tutores,

El próximo año ya se aproxima, y queremos compartir con ustedes la guía que hemos recibido del Departamento de Educación de Arizona y del Centro de Prevenciones de Enfermedades (CDC) acerca del Covid-19 en referente a situaciones de viajes fuera del país.

Si usted planea viajar fuera de los Estados Unidos de América, tendrá que estar en una cuarentena de 14 días antes que pueda regresar a la escuela. Esto aplica para todos los estudiantes, maestros y todo el personal educativo. Cualquier persona que viaje fuera de los Estados Unidos de América tendrá que regresar para el 5 de Julio para poder estar listo para el primer día de escuela que será Julio 20, 2020.

Viajeros que viajen fuera del país deberán seguir estos pasos durante la cuarentena al regresar de su viaje:

- Tomarse la temperatura dos veces al día y monitorearla.
- Estar alerta de tos o problemas al respirar.
- Quedarse en casa y evitar contacto con otros fuera del hogar.
- No asistir a la escuela y/o al trabajo por 14 días y discutir su situación con el distrito antes de regresar.
- No tomar transportación pública, compartir viajes, o camiones durante la práctica del distanciamiento social.
- Evite lugares llenos de gente (como centros comerciales y cines) y limite sus actividades en público y mantenga su distancia de otros (por lo menos 6 pies).

La salud y seguridad de nuestros estudiantes, personal educativo y nuestra comunidad es nuestra prioridad. Si tiene alguna pregunta, favor de llamarnos.
